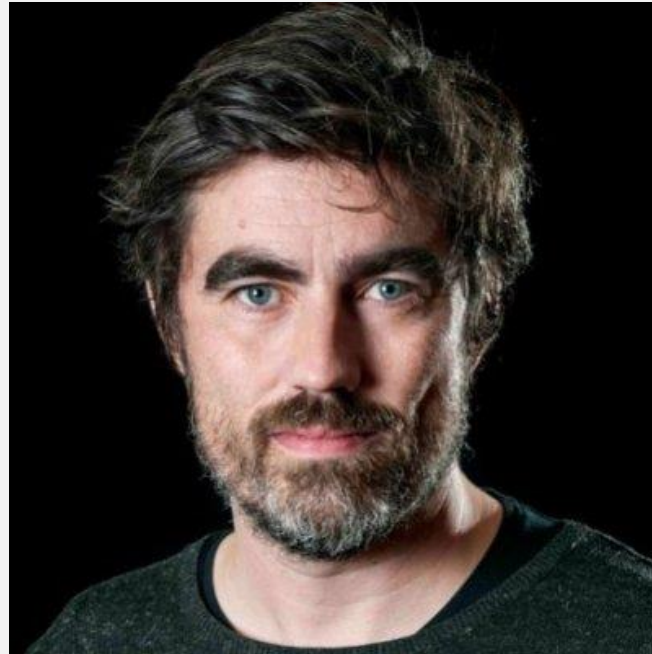




ERAI 2016 Update

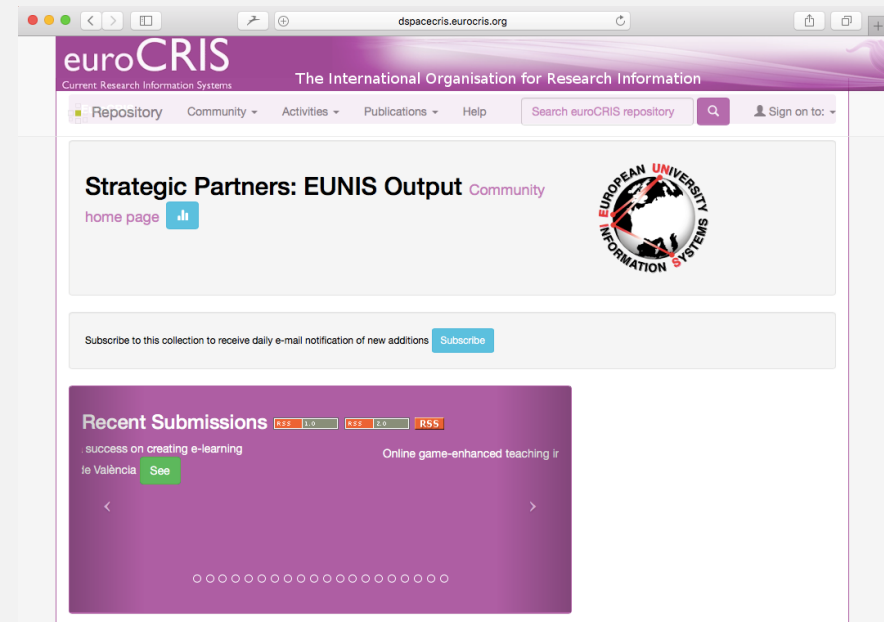

Plans for the next year

- For each thematic publication we will seek to create additional content - case studies, interviews linked to Current reports
 - For the two areas we have created during 2015
 - CRIS
 - CLOUD
- Trans-national benchmarking
 - During the spring of 2016 we have been working with EUNIS, Spanish and Dutch benchmarking initiatives to find common ground for benchmarking.
 - Focus is on the aggregated view, rather than intra-institutional comparison.
 - We've identified a set of questions that can be distributed.
