

An initiative of the Erasmus Without Paper project (EWP)

- an open repository of source code
- to help the higher education community
- sharing open source solutions developed by their respective teams.



Why?

- HEIs are developing IT tools that can support the management of, for example, their student mobility;
- An alternative to working individually share the source code of their applications, eliminating redundancy.
- the HEIs would both dramatically accelerate their ability and enhance the efficiency and cost management for their information systems.
- To promote real collaboration and exchange of expertise among IT teams, which in turn would lead to higher security and quality standards.



- From 2019 to 2021, the vast majority of European HEIs will be looking to connect their student information systems (SIS) to the EWP Network;
- The EWP proposes a new way to accelerate the adoption of SIS, with sharing code;
- Developers can access to a catalogue of modules, developed by peers which can be adapted to the needs of their own HEI and once again shared with the community.
