DIGITAL INFRASTRUCTURE

- A European student eID scheme for higher education.
- To allow mobile students to safely and seamlessly identify and authenticate themselves.
- And access e-services (Once Only Principle)



How are we going to achieve this?

- eduGAIN
- European Student Identifier
- eIDAS

b) Integrating the European Student eID into four e-services:

- Online Learning Agreement
- Erasmus+ Mobile App
- Erasmus Dashboard
- PhD Hub Platform





Interfederation service

- Connects identity federations.
- Users can identify and authenticate electronically using a single identity provided by their home institution (SSO).
- Simplifies access to content, services and resources for the research and education community.

Regulation on electronic identification and trust services for electronic transactions in the internal market

- Adopted in 2014.
- Entered into force in 2016.
- Enable secure and seamless electronic transactions between businesses, citizens and public authorities.
- Allow EU citizens to use their national eID scheme to access public services in other Member States.





THE EUROPEAN STUDENT CARD

ESC Project

- Establish a common digital and graphic identity on European student cards.
- Allow students to assert their student rights and access student services anywhere in Europe.

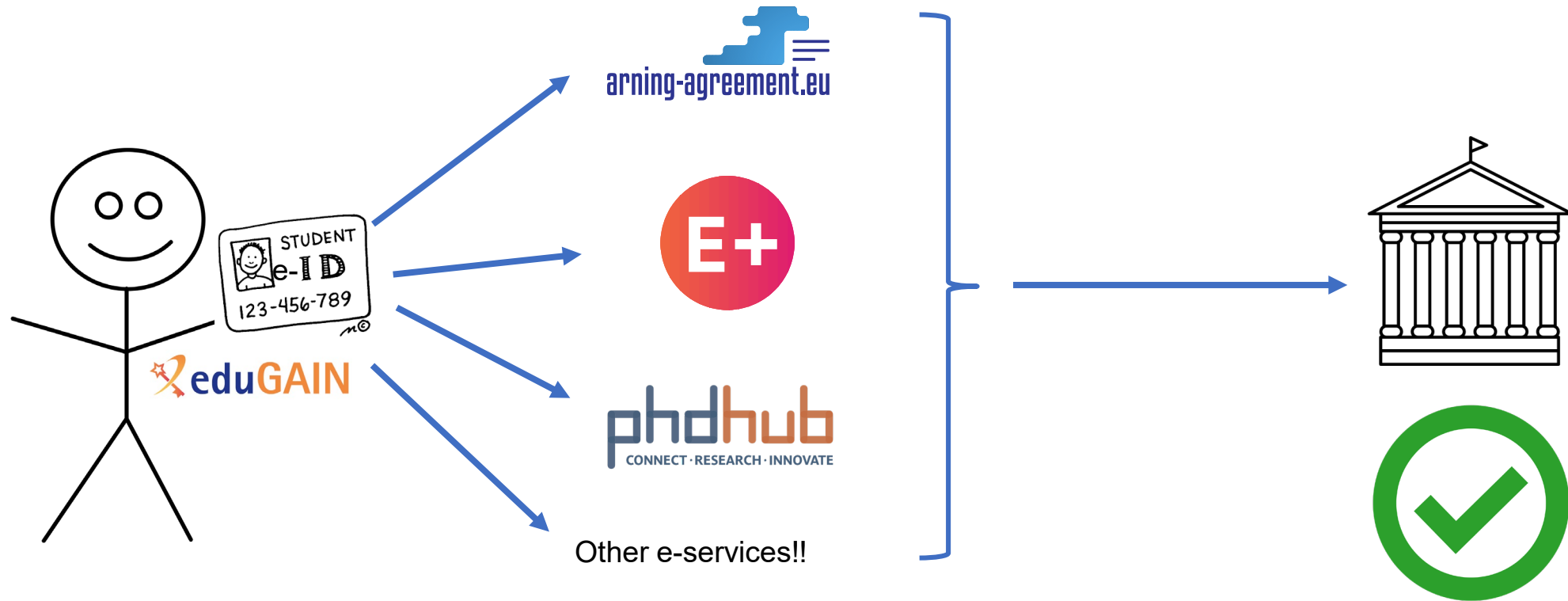
