
## **BencHEIT Survey / The survey**

- Free of charge
- A survey on IT costs and volumes of higher education institutes.
- Invented, developed and managed by CIOs (within EUNIS community)
- No need to be EUNIS member
- Participants see the analysis and each others complete data.
- Cash flow based → fluctuation between years especially for one organisation.

# **BencHEIT Survey / Survey statistics**

- Number of participants vary by country and year
  - BM2023 had only 37 participants
  - Survey is most popular among Norway and Finland
    e.g. BM2023 results covers 95%\* of Finnish universities

### **BM2023**

IT cost of organisation: 2,5M€ – 90,5M€

Organisation's staff FTE: 300 – 8 500


IT costs per degree: 800€ – 12 000€

IT staff from total staff: 2,2% - 7,8%






# BM2023 / IT costs' share from total costs of university








# BencHEIT Survey / Dimensions and share of costs\* (BM2023)








# BM2023 / IT costs by account group: Universities








#### BM2023 / Volume data










# **BM-survey / Longitudinal analysis / Case: NTNU, Norway**










HEI's are investing in different services different amounts each year








Occasionally BM questionnaire may have additional small voluntary ad-hoc surveys on current topics. This year it was on AI.

### **BM2023 Artificial Intelligence / Additional survey**

#### 36 respondents

- Who is responsible of assessing and implementing AI tools?
- Some answers relate to "Generic Al" only
- IT is involved in each case if there is a process
- 7/36 is Unclear or no process






## **BM2023 Artificial Intelligence / Additional survey**

#### 115 answers


- Which processes use Ai tools (May 2024)?
- Some very specific purposes
  - IT security
  - video captions
  - plagiarism checking
- Lot of IT testing/piloting especially in administrative services
- Use in research sometimes "under the radar"



## **BM2023 Artificial Intelligence / Additional survey**

#### 115 answers

- Which tools are most popular (May 2024)?
- Some universities did not name any individual products just "many" or "plenty"
- Most popular within Microsoft is Copilot in various versions (16/20)
- OpenAl's ChatGPT in various versions (15/25)
